the Accounting Technicians Diploma (ATD), Certified Tax Advisor (CTA), Certified Public Accountants of Uganda [CPA(U)], courses and the masterclass for holders of Foreign Accountancy Qualifications (FAQ).

Today, we celebrate the fruits of your dedication, hard work, and perseverance. This journey has been long for some of you, but your commitment has remained unwavering. Pursuing a professional course requires tremendous focus, determination, and sacrifice, but the rewards are worth every effort. You are now positioned for tremendous career growth and advancement opportunities, having met the required professional standards and competencies.

We continue to see a positive trend in registration for examinations, particularly CPA(U), reflecting the growing commitment to professionalism in Uganda and beyond.

Today, we are proud to recognise 32 ATD graduates, 19 CTA graduates, 272 CPA graduates, and 81 pioneer graduates of the masterclass for holders of FAQ. This masterclass was introduced to provide a simplified route for membership enrolment among holders of FAQ who missed the opportunity to apply for ICPAU membership in the moratorium window of 2011 under the East African Community Institutes of Accountants (EACIAs) Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA). We will have the second and final edition of the masterclass between 21 – 25 July this year. Holders of FAQ who completed their FAQs by the end of 2013 are encouraged to apply.

Let me take this opportunity to remind you about the Uganda Accountancy Qualifications Framework (UAQF).

Approved by the National Council for Higher Education in 2023, the framework positions professional accountancy on the Higher Education Qualifications Framework for Uganda.

With it came the equating of the various levels of the CPA(U) course. It therefore clears the doubts about where a CPA (U) holder stands as far as the higher education in Uganda is concerned. As graduates today, you need to understand the framework and use it to your advantage and defend your qualification against the doubting thomases.

The framework also addresses the misconceptions surrounding professional accountancy qualifications and their relevance in job selections. The UAQF recommends prioritising CPA holders, regardless of whether they possess a bachelor's degree for accountancy-related roles. Additionally, CPA has become a prerequisite for admissions into Master of Business Administration (MBA) and Master of Science (MSC) programmes in Accounting and Finance without necessarily one holding a bachelor's degree. CPA opens doors to advanced education and career opportunities.

As a reminder, continuing ATD students have up to December 2025 to be examined by PAEB. Thereafter, those who will not have completed the course will be assessed by the Uganda Business and Technical Examinations Board (UBTEB). The ATD course will remain accredited by ICPAU, and ATD graduates will be exempted from Level 1 of the CPA(U) course.

We can proudly say that our examinations system is the route to a sustainable accountancy profession, tailored to meet the human resource needs of the economy. As CPA graduates, you are equipped to serve in any organisation or country, because the qualification is well aligned with international accounting education standards.

Congratulations to the top candidates at each level for your outstanding performance. I wish to encourage you to use your knowledge and skills to excel and inspire the next generation. Let us continue to be ambassadors of our profession, making a lasting impact in every opportunity we encounter and upholding our integrity in our spaces.

Finally, I would like to express my sincere appreciation to all stakeholders involved in the examinations process - parents, students, examiners, markers, invigilators, moderators, PAEB, and tuition providers. Your contributions are invaluable.





Graduates of CPA (U) have attained the first requirement to become CPAs. They qualify to become Associate members of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Uganda (ICPAU) straight away, if they do have the required experience.

Associate membership is a category which enables CPA graduates to remain connected with the Institute while they gain the mandatory 3 years of Practical Experience Training (PET) required for enrolment to Full Membership. Those with the relevant experience qualify to be enroled for full membership of ICPAU to be eligible for using the CPA initials.

The UAQF Recommends Prioritising CPA Graduates for Accountancy Roles



The National Council for Higher Education (NHCE) undertook a significant step towards enhancing the quality and comparability of qualifications in Uganda. On 20 January 2023, the NCHE approved the Uganda Accountancy Qualifications Framework (UAQF), a vital subset of the broader Uganda Higher Education Qualifications Framework (UHEQF).

The UAQF aims to provide a standardised basis for assessing and comparing accountancy qualifications. By establishing a common framework, it addresses the misconceptions surrounding professional accountancy qualifications and their relevance in job selections. Whether you are an employer or an aspiring accountant, understanding the UAQF is crucial.

One of the key revelations within the UAQF is the compatibility between the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) qualification and the Postgraduate Diploma (PGD). Contrary to popular belief, a CPA holds its own against a bachelor's. Employers seeking to hire accountants should take note. The UAQF recommends prioritising CPA holders, regardless of whether they possess a bachelor's degree for accountancy-related roles.

The Accountants Act, 2013 underscores the importance of professional accountancy qualifications. To be recognised as an accountant, one must hold such a qualification. The UAQF reinforces this requirement,

emphasising that a bachelor's degree is optional. What truly matters is the profession of a CPA – a credential that signifies expertise and competence.

Today, HEIs recognise the value of a CPA. It has become a prerequisite for admissions into Master of Business Administration (MBA) and Master of Science (MSc) programmes in Accounting and Finance without necessarily one holding a bachelor's degree. Aspiring students should not underestimate the significance of the CPA qualification. It opens doors to advanced education and career opportunities.

In light of these developments, the public is urged to uphold the CPA professional accountancy qualification's role in the market. The UAQF ensures that accountants are evaluated fairly based on their expertise rather than their academic educational background.

As Uganda continues strengthening its educational landscape, the UAQF is a beacon of clarity and equity. Employers, educators, and aspiring accountants alike can now confidently navigate the path to success.





ATD Graduands by Gender


CTA Graduands by Gender





NOTE: Apart from fully recognised members from the EACIAs, other holders of Foreign Accountancy Qualification (FAQ) may be required to sit for all or some of the following:

- CPA 5 Business & Company Law
- CPA 13 Public Financial Management
- CPA 16 Audit Practice & Assurance
- CPA 17 Advanced Taxation

Exemption from CPA 5 Business & Company Law may be granted if it was covered during the first degree pursued in Uganda.

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- a) Printed, completed, and signed online application form
- b) Completed documentation of Practical Experience Training (PET) in the PET logbook
- c) Recommendation letters from:
 - i. Either current or former employer within the past three years, and;
 - ii. A full member of ICPAU in good standing, known to the applicant personally.
- d) Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- e) Original or certified copies of academic support documents; transcripts and certificates for O-level, A-level, diplomas, degrees and professional courses.
- f) Proof of payment of enrolment fees
- g) One (1) colour photograph (passport type with white background)


